



RYDER CUP BOUND

CAPTAINS ADD MAHAN, WESTWOOD

MAHAN WILL PLAY ON HIS THIRD U.S. RYDER CUP TEAM.

THIS YEAR'S RYDER CUP WILL BE WESTWOOD'S 9TH STRAIGHT.

It was a memorable Tuesday for Hunter Mahan and Lee Westwood, who were named captain's picks on the U.S. and European Ryder Cup teams, respectively, for the matches Sept. 26-28 in Scotland. Mahan played on the 2008 and 2010 teams, while Westwood has competed in every Ryder Cup for Europe since 1997, nine in a row.

Mahan won his sixth PGA Tour title two weeks ago and joins fellow PING Pro Bubba Watson on the U.S. roster.

Westwood said he's been rounding into form at the right time. "I've been playing a lot better in the last month and a half and I'm delighted and honored to be representing Europe again."

HORSCHEL ADVANCES WITH G30 DRIVER

Billy Horschel's T2 at the Deutsche Bank Championship elevated him 62 places in FedExCup points and earned him a spot in the next leg of the playoffs this week at the BMW Championship in Colorado. He relied on a G30 driver, S55 irons, and a Karsten TR

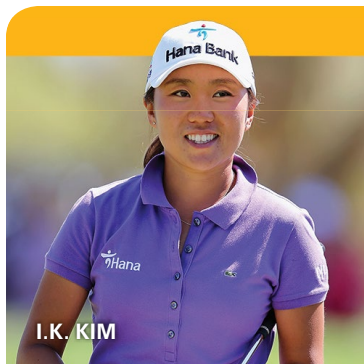
putter (see What's in the Bag next page). It was his best result of the season and his third top 10.

Horschel averaged 306 yards off the tee and in the final round hit 85.71% of fairways.

He is 20th among the 70 players who advanced to the BMW.

KIM POSTS SECOND

In her second tournament with a G30 driver, I.K. earned her way into a playoff and finished solo second at the Portland Classic. She hit 43 of 56 fairways for the week. In addition to the G30 driver, she played G25 fairway woods, i25 hybrids and i25 irons, and a Karsten TR Anser 2 putter. Kim won earlier this year on the Ladies European Tour. She tees it up next at the LPGA's final major, the Evian Championship, Sept. 11-14.
